The first ever tour of historic Jamesport will include five of the houses portrayed by local artist Fred Bender in his painting, “Sunday Morning in James Port, May 1839.” The 12 homes featured on the tour range from Italianate mansions of prosperous sea captains to cottages of humble tradespersons. There’s even a tavern turned into a residence. The tour can be walked or cars can be parked at several locations along the route.

The 1731 Jamesport Meeting House was acquired last year by The Jamesport Meeting House Preservation Trust to ensure it will remain permanently in community hands.
